Body Brain Adventure Lab 3-6th Grade

Typically students will spend 2-5 minutes at each station, rotating at the sound of the buzzer. Some of the stations include flip chart holders. The content of the flip chart holders can be customized based on the curriculum for that day or teachers can use the provided flip card curriculum. This is great for students reviewing facts before tests! Students can also pair up and work with partners- One student will be moving while the other is quizzing them

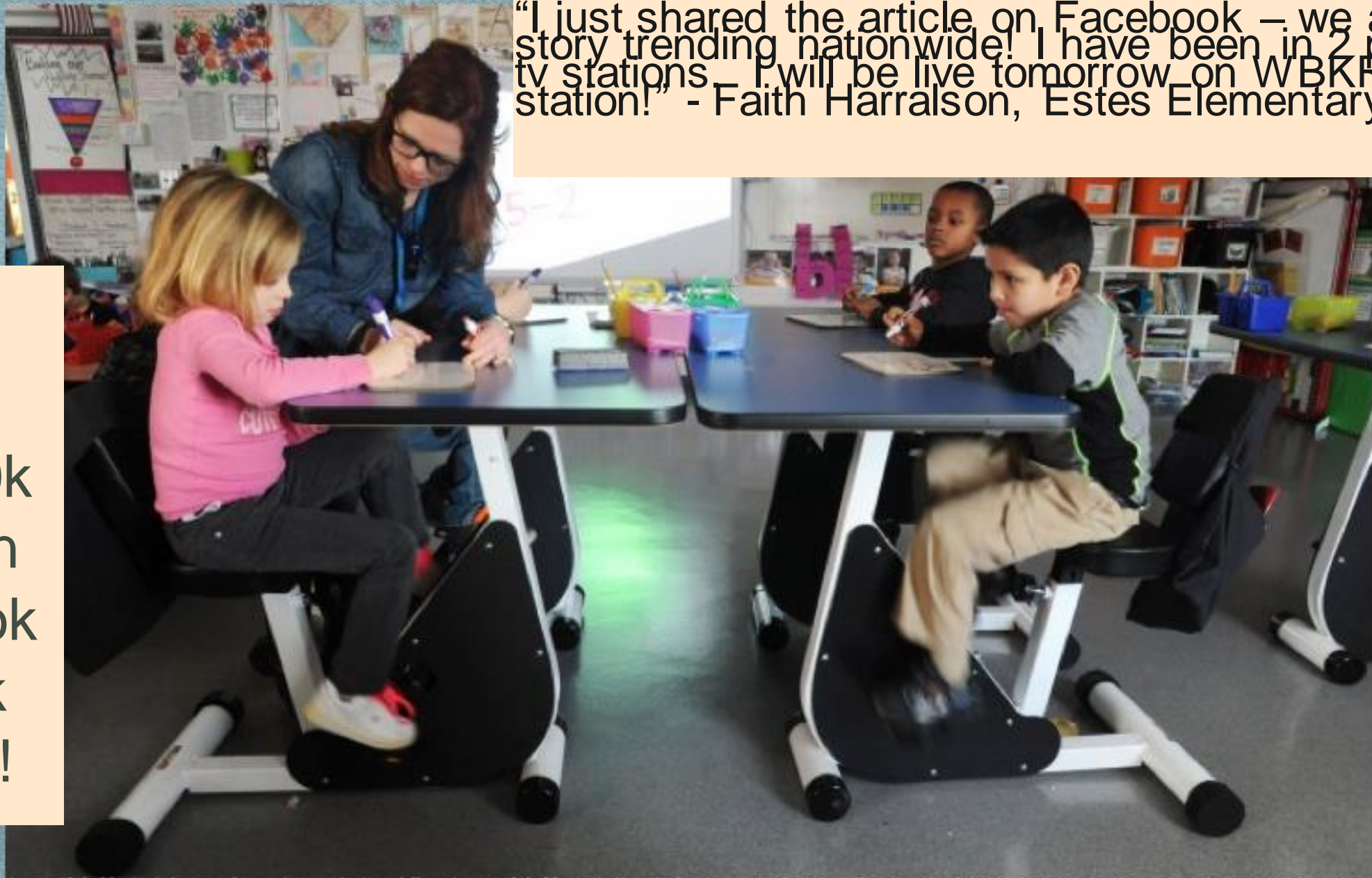

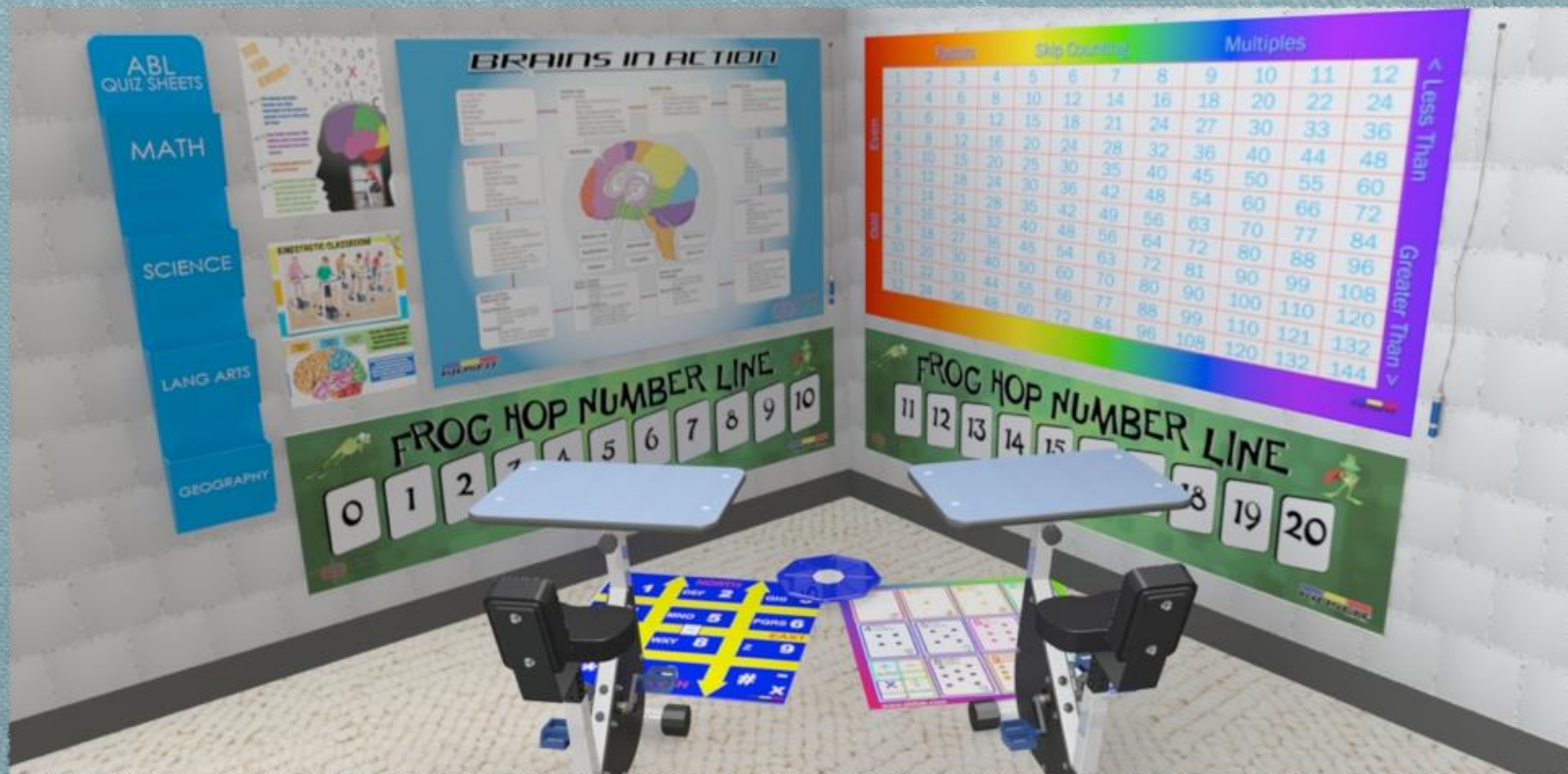

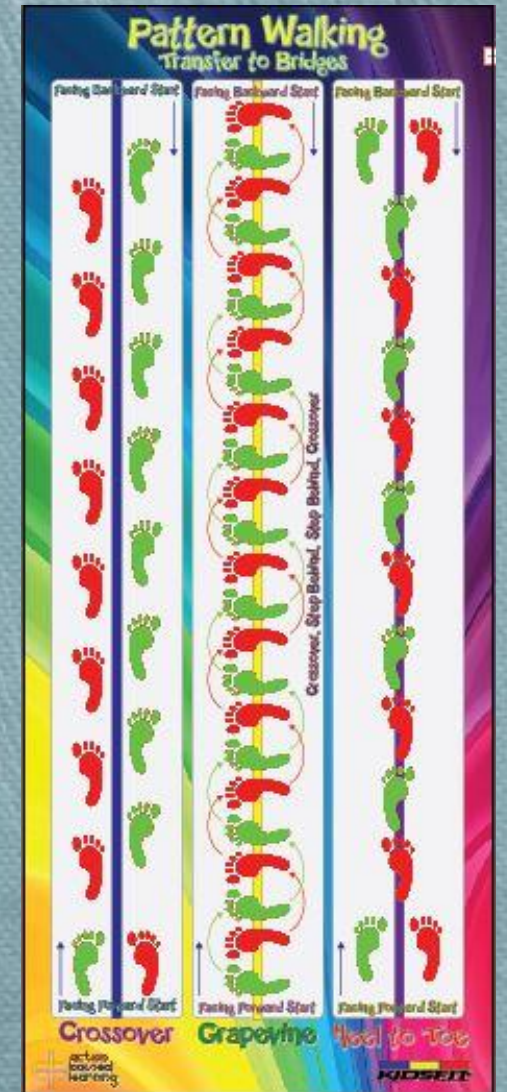
