




# FROM BERRY HILL FARM QUARRY TO KINGSMEAD QUARRY

0.6 mi	Turn left onto Route 61
75 ft	Turn right to stay on Route 61
3.7 mi	Turn right to stay on Route 61
30 ft	Turn right to stay on Route 61
0.4 mi	Turn left to stay on Route 61
23 ft	Turn right towards Route 61
82 ft	Turn left at Slough Rd/A332
0.2 mi	Turn right at Slough Rd/A332

DISTANCE TO TRAVEL	DIRECTIONS
381 ft	Slight left towards Hall Ct
43 ft	Turn right onto Hall Ct
1.3 mi	Turn left onto London Rd/B376
0.5 mi	At the roundabout, take the 1st exit onto Datchet Rd
0.7 mi	Datchet Rd turns slightly left and becomes Stanwell Rd
0.9 mi	Turn right onto Coppermill Rd
423 ft	Turn right onto Old Mill Pl
0.0 mi	Arrive at Kingsmead Quarry Welley Road, Horton, Slough, Berkshire, SL3 9QA (51.464255° -0.5442325°)





### **SAFETY ADVICE**

#### Please ensure you do not enter onto any quarry site.

Ensure follow all road markings and are aware of your surroundings.

Wear appropriate clothing and be prepared for changing weather conditions.

Only undertake the route if it is within your cycling and fitness capability and ensure you schedule in refreshment breaks in along the way.

Check all of your equipment is in good condition.

Environmental conditions can change the nature of the trails within a short space of time, you should only continue if safe to do so.

It's also a good idea to ensure you have a basic first aid kit with you.

## **ENVIRONMENTAL GOOD PRACTICE**
