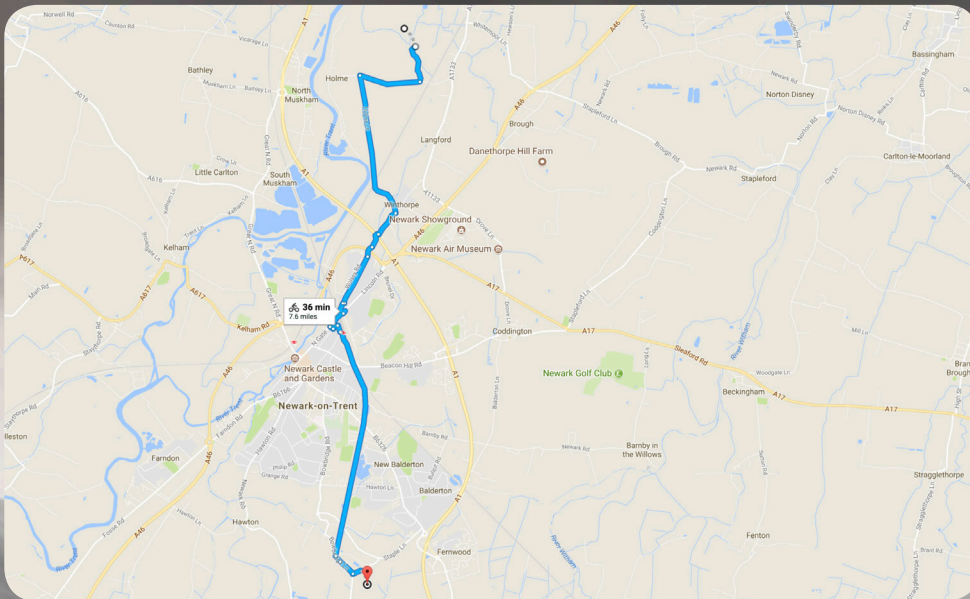

1.7 mi	Turn left to stay on Holme Ln/National Cycle Route 64
0.3 mi	Turn right onto Gainsborough Rd/National Cycle Route 64
0.2 mi	Turn right onto National Cycle Route 64
0.1 mi	Turn right to stay on National Cycle Route 64
30 ft	Turn right onto Winthorpe Rd
0.6 mi	Slight left onto National Cycle Route 64/Winthorpe Rd
95 ft	Turn right onto Hatchet's Ln/National Cycle Route 64
0.1 mi	Turn left to stay on Hatchet's Ln/National Cycle Route 64
0.3 mi	Slight left to stay on National Cycle Route 64
223 ft	Turn left onto National Cycle Route 64/Summer's Rd
377 ft	Turn left onto Alliance St/National Cycle Route 64
417 ft	Turn right onto Lincoln St/National Cycle Route 64
105 ft	Turn left towards National Cycle Route 64
2.6 mi	Turn right onto National Cycle Route 64
440 ft	Turn left towards Bowbridge Ln
0.2 mi	Slight left onto Bowbridge Ln

SAFETY ADVICE

Please ensure you do not enter onto any quarry site.

Ensure follow all road markings and are aware of your surroundings.

Wear appropriate clothing and be prepared for changing weather conditions.

Only undertake the route if it is within your cycling and fitness capability and ensure you schedule in refreshment breaks in along the way.

Check all of your equipment is in good condition.

Environmental conditions can change the nature of the trails within a short space of time, you should only continue if safe to do so.

It's also a good idea to ensure you have a basic first aid kit with you.

ENVIRONMENTAL GOOD PRACTICE

We all have a responsibility to protect the countryside now and for future generations, so make sure you don't harm animals, birds, plants or trees and try to leave no trace of your visit.

Do not disturb wildlife, leave the environment as you find it and follow a path or track if there is one.

Leave gates and property as you find them.

Look after the places you visit and ensure all litter is taken home with you.
