Wear comfortable clothes, close-toed shoes, and bring work gloves if you have them. All other tools and supplies will be provided.

Youth under 14 must be supervised one-on-one by an adult who is at least 21 years old. Volunteers 14-17 must be supervised by an adult who is at least 21 at a ratio of 1 adult to 4 youth.
