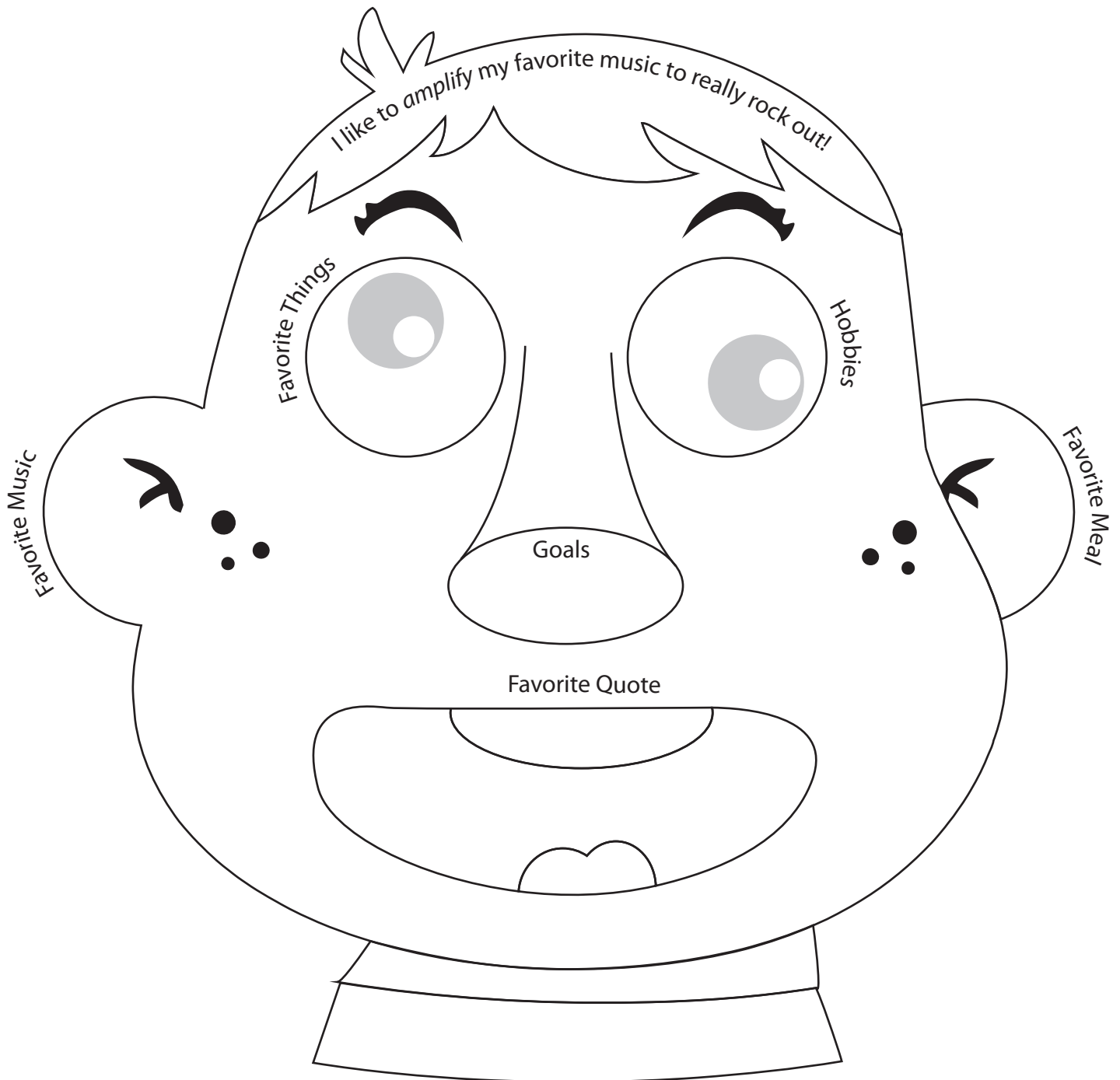


Your Face Tells Your Story
