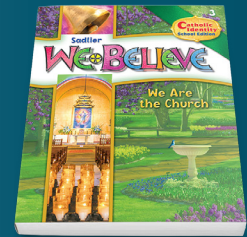
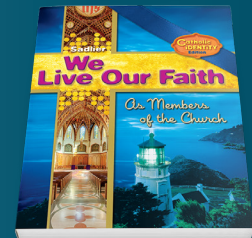

Introduction

Personal Safety skills, both in the real world and in the digital world are essential for each and every child. The Bishops of the United States back in 2002 drafted a landmark document recommitting themselves to the safety of our children and young people; it is referred to as: *The Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People*. They want to be sure there are training programs in place for all adults who came in contact with children and young people, as well as programs to educate children about personal safety. Every diocese is mandated to offer educational programs in every school and parish, to every child, every year. This mandate is to teach safety in accordance with Catholic moral principles.

The National Center for Missing and Exploited Children (NCMEC) is a nonprofit, nondenominational organization operating since 1984 as the national clearinghouse and resource center for families, victims, private organizations, law enforcement, and the public on issues relating to missing and sexually exploited children. The NCMEC has created two programs which help fill the diocesan mandate, KidSmartz and NetSmartz. The NCMEC Internet safety program (NetSmartz) has been in use since 2012. Real-world safety smarts was being talked about as a way to keep kids safe, but Internet safety was the new threat in town. NetSmartz was there to fill that need and provided a targeted safety skills program to help kids navigate the Internet and gaming sites safely. KidSmartz, a child-safety program focused on abduction prevention and personal safety empowerment (created in partnership with Honeywell), was introduced in 2015 and provides excellent education targeting real world safety for students in grades K–5, and compliments the Internet safety lessons offered in NetSmartz. These programs can be found at www.kidsmartz.org and www.netsmartz.org with videos and resources for parents, teachers, catechists, and children.

It is essential to provide quality, engaging, personal safety education to children every year. That said, we are delighted to offer this correlation which allows NCMEC programs integration with Sadlier's *We Believe* and *We Live Our Faith* Catholic Identity Religion programs. Although this is not the only way one can use the NCMEC resources, this is a suggested manner in which to deliver the NCMEC programs while teaching about our Catholic faith. This resource saves teacher planning time and meets the requirements of *The Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People*. Integrating the NCMEC videos along with the Sadlier Religion curriculum will allow you to reach and teach kids essential safety skills.

Together, we can equip all children with the skills they need to be safe in the real world and online. Thank you for all that you do to keep children and vulnerable adults safe.
