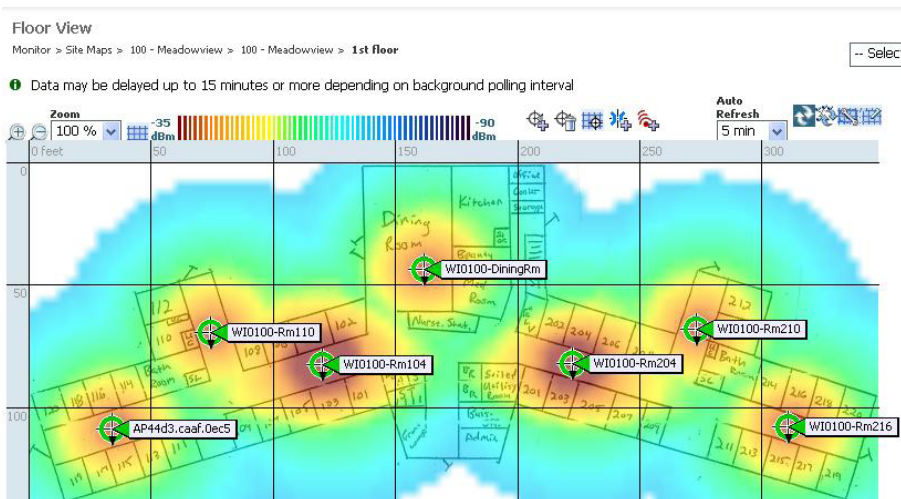


Continuity improves your business productivity

Our network site assessment includes:

- **Network connectivity:** Review and assess the network router(s) and circuit(s) to confirm the stability and cleanliness of the circuit(s). Depending on our access and the devices being used, this includes the type of traffic, the configuration, the setup and the health of the device.
- **Wireless connectivity:** If the community has wireless, we perform a wireless survey to determine coverage and potential gaps and strengths.
- **Local area network (LAN):** Review the local facility network including switching, etc.
- **Endpoint discovery:** Assess the devices being used by your personnel to determine the devices and capabilities. This inventory of your devices is available to you afterwards.
